**KEY RESULT AREA**

One Fresno

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends the City Council authorize the Director of Aviation to sign the Military Construction Cooperative Agreement (MCCA) on behalf of the City of Fresno. The MCCA provides legal access to the National Guard Bureau (NGB) for repair of their aircraft arresting gear at the approach end of runway 11R at Fresno Yosemite International Airport (FYI). There is no obligation of funding or labor provided by the City of Fresno in this agreement.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This agreement will allow the NGB to repair the BAK-12 arresting gear at the approach end of runway 11R at FYI. The National Guard Bureau (NGB) has secured funding to replace certain components of the BAK-12 that have shown indications of wear. The BAK-12 is an aircraft arresting unit which prevents a runway overrun due to flight systems malfunction or pilot error. The NGB will put the project out to bid, secure a contractor and inspect the work. The City of Fresno will provide a Right of Entry for the Air National Guard and it's contractors to perform the work. There are no City of Fresno funds or labor being provided for this work. The installed equipment remains the property of the NGB and the current Joint Use Agreement remains in effect.

**KEY OBJECTIVE BALANCE**

This Agreement is for the sole purpose of providing legal access to the site for the NGB. There are no Key Objectives as there is no active involvement by City forces.

**BACKGROUND**

The BAK-12 unit is an aircraft arresting system used by military aircraft to prevent potential runway overruns due to flight systems malfunction or pilot error. The unit in question is located at the 11R end of Runway 11R/29L at FYI. Certain components of the unit have shown signs of wear and require replacement, which will require the closing of runway 11R/29L during construction. Airport staff will coordinate the runway closures with the Air National Guard. The NGB will provide the plans and

specifications, bid the project and manage all construction documents. The Airports Safety and Security Requirements will be included in each bid package provided to contractors. The MCCA states that the NGB will contract for construction, inspect and accept the work and in turn the City of Fresno will provide a Right of Entry to the Air National Guard and its contractors to complete the work.


#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

There is no impact to the General Fund or to the budget of the Department of Airports from this action. The National Guard Bureau will provide all project funding.


