SUBJECT: AUTHORIZE ACCEPTANCE OF THE BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP GRANT AWARD OF \$14,416 AND EXECUTION OF PROGRAM DOCUMENTS, AND ADOPT THE 69<sup>th</sup> AMENDMENT TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION 2008-162 APPROPRIATING \$14,400 IN THE FY 09 BUDGET

#### KEY RESULT AREA

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the City Council authorize acceptance of grant funds and adopt the 69<sup>th</sup> amendment to AAR No. 2008-162 appropriating \$14,400 into the FY 09 budget for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant program.

#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, awarded the Fresno Police Department \$14,416 in grant funds for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant program. A local match requirement of 50 percent, or an additional \$14,416, will be provided from the Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund (SLESF) grant. The SLESF grant was approved by Council on September 30, 2008.

#### KEY OBJECTIVE BALANCE

The Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant program balances the three key objectives of prudent Financial Management, Employee Satisfaction, and Customer Satisfaction by bringing in grant funding to provide lifesaving bulletproof vests for police officers who are continually placing their lives in danger to protect the community.

#### BACKGROUND

For safety reasons, the Fresno Police Department follows the manufacturer's recommendation to replace vests every five years. The City of Fresno purchases vests using woven kevlar, gold flex, and dineema.

These vests contain no Zylon products. Vest containing Zylon have failed some testing by the National Institute of Justice. The City of Fresno does not purchase vests with Zylon. Since 1999, the Department has been receiving grant funds from the Bureau of Justice Assistance to assist with the purchase and replacement of vests.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

There is no negative impact to the General Fund.
