SUBJECT: AWARD A CONTRACT TO GRANITE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$255,140.00 FOR THE INSTALLATION OF STREET INFRASTRUCTURE IN NO NEIGHBORHOOD LEFT BEHIND AREA 63 (COUNCIL DISTRICT NO. 5)

KEY RESULT AREA

One Fresno

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council award a contract in the amount of \$255,140.00 to Granite Construction Company as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This project is for the replacement or installation of missing street infrastructure in the No Neighborhood Left Behind (NNLB) Area 63 bounded by Church, Jensen, Chestnut and Cedar Avenues in Southeast Fresno. The work will consist of replacing or installing street paving, curb ramps, curb, gutter and sidewalk.

KEY OBJECTIVE BALANCE

This project best balances the three Key Objectives of Customer Satisfaction, Employee Satisfaction and prudent Fiscal Management. This project will provide the necessary street infrastructure for this neighborhood in Southeast Fresno. This project will also enhance the appearance of the neighborhood and provide better storm water drainage. This project was competitively bid which adheres to the key objective of prudent Fiscal Management.

BACKGROUND

This project is for the replacement or installation of missing street infrastructure in the No Neighborhood Left Behind (NNLB) Area 63 bounded by Church, Jensen, Chestnut and Cedar Avenues in Southeast Fresno. The work will consist of replacing or installing street paving, curb ramps, curb, gutter and sidewalk.

Plans and Specifications were prepared and a Notice of Inviting Bids was published in the Business Journal on February 9, 2007, posted on the City's website and faxed to eleven (11) builder exchanges. The specifications were distributed to ten (10) prospective bidders. Four (4) bid proposals were received and opened in a public bid opening on March 8, 2007. Bid proposal prices ranged from \$255,140.00 to \$292,991.00.

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Award Contract to Granite Construction Co.
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Granite Construction Company submitted the lowest bid price in the amount of \$255,140.00 and is considered the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Staff recommends that the City Council award a contract in the amount of \$ 255,140.00 to Granite Construction Company as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

The project will be completed in 30 working days from issuance of Notice to Proceed.


