SUBJECT: AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF FRESNO TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE 21st DISTRICT AGRICULTURE ASSOCIATION TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES AT THE 2007 FRESNO DISTRICT FAIR

KEY RESULT AREA

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the City of Fresno to enter into an agreement with the 21st District Agriculture Association to provide police services at the 2007 Fresno District Fair.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

An agreement is attached for Council to approve the 21st District Agricultural Association request to contract with the City of Fresno to provide police and law enforcement services at the 2007 Fresno District Fair, commencing October 3, 2007, and continuing through October 14, 2007.

KEY OBJECTIVE BALANCE

This proposal to enter into a contract with the 21st District Agriculture Association to provide police services will balance the three key result areas of Customer Service, Financial Management and Employee Service. Customer Service is met by the Police Department providing contract law enforcement services to meet the safety and security concerns of those citizens attending and working at the fair. Financial Management is met by the Fresno Fair contracting police services, which will have no financial impact on the City. Additionally, Employee Service to the community will not be impacted by the Police Department working at the fair since this is a contract policing event.

BACKGROUND

As done in past years, policing and related law enforcement services will be provided in areas at the fairgrounds that have been mutually agreed upon by fair management and Fresno Police Department representatives.

This year's agreement calls for 4,834 hours of law enforcement services and the cost for 10 jail booking fees, totaling \$233,057.40. This amount has been calculated to cover the direct cost incurred by the Police

Department for services provided at the 2007 Fresno District Fair. The agreement also contains cost for any unforeseen circumstances requiring additional police services. One hundred contingency hours, totaling \$4,721, have been set aside to protect the Fresno District Fair and the Police Department in the event any unforeseen problems occur.

The agreement has been reviewed and approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office and by the Risk Management Division.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no direct fiscal impact to the City, as all law enforcement service expenses will be reimbursed by the 21st District Agricultural Association.
