

SUBJECT: APPROVE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT AWARD FOR \$273,300 FROM THE METROPOLITAN MEDICAL RESPONSE SYSTEM GRANT PROGRAM, THROUGH THE COUNTY OF FRESNO, AND AUTHORIZE THE FIRE CHIEF TO COMPLETE ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

1. RESOLUTION - AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF FY11 CYCLE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY/OFFICE OF DOMESTIC PREPAREDNESS "METROPOLITAN MEDICAL RESPONSE SYSTEM" GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING, THROUGH THE COUNTY OF FRESNO, AND AUTHORIZING COMPLETION OF DOCUMENTS
2. RESOLUTION - 52ND AMENDMENT TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION (AAR) NO. 2011-133, APPROPRIATING \$273,300 FROM THE METROPOLITAN MEDICAL RESPONSE SYSTEM GRANT TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE TRAINING, EQUIPMENT, MEDICAL SUPPLIES, AND CONTINUING PROGRAM OVERSIGHT

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended Council adopt the resolution to accept the Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) grant for \$273,300 and the 52nd amendment to AAR No. 2011-133 to appropriate funding to the FY12 Fire Department budget.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Since 2002, the Fire Department has been one of the lead agencies for the MMRS program. This program is now administered under the auspices of the Department of Homeland Security and provides grant funding for local jurisdictions to establish and maintain a comprehensive initial on-site response plan in the event of a disaster or terrorist attack. MMRS funding covers program oversight, training, acquisition of pharmaceuticals, medical and personal protective equipment, and other equipment necessary to provide for mass decontamination, mass triage, mass patient care, and mass fatality management.

BACKGROUND

A State MMRS Grant Program has been made available through the U. S, Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Office of Domestic Preparedness (ODP). The Fire Department was included in the grant process,

along with other Fresno County public safety and law enforcement agencies. Grant awards have been made, and the Fire Department was awarded \$273,300.

An adopted City Council resolution is required to enable the Fire Department to process the grant, to allow the Fire Chief to sign all required grant documents, and to receive payment of the grant funds.

Adoption of the resolution authorizing the Fire Department to use the grant funds means the City will provide training and equipment to personnel for disaster preparedness efforts. Additionally, acceptance accomplishes the intent of the DHS grant.

Denial of the resolution means the Fire Department will not enhance its incident capabilities and the intent of the grant will not be accomplished.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact to the general fund. All acquisitions will be fully reimbursed from authorized grant funding.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF FY 2011 CYCLE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY/OFFICE OF DOMESTIC PREPAREDNESS "METROPOLITAN MEDICAL RESPONSE SYSTEM" GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING, THROUGH THE COUNTY OF FRESNO, AND AUTHORIZING COMPLETION OF RELATED DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security provides funding for the FY 2011 Cycle Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant Program ("Program") which is administered through the Office of Domestic Preparedness ("ODP"); and

WHEREAS, the procedures established by the ODP require the applicant to certify by resolution approval of the grant award; and

WHEREAS, the applicant will enter into an agreement with ODP and any collaborating local agencies and entities for the grant funded Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno:

Section 1. That Council approves acceptance of grant funds for the U.S. Department of Homeland Security through the ODP for FY 2011 Cycle Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant Program, contingent upon grant funds being available.

Section 2. To the extent consistent with all Constitution and local law requirements and this resolution, the City certifies that it has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the Program.

Section 3. That the City certifies it has reviewed, understands and, to the extent consistent with all Constitutional and local law requirements and this resolution, agrees to the provisions contained in the Application, Award and Program Guidelines.

Section 4. The Fire Chief for the City of Fresno, is appointed the agent of the City of Fresno, to conduct all negotiations and take any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining the federal financial assistance hereunder, execute and submit documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, memoranda of understanding, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the Program, subject to prior approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
