SUBJECT: AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT WITH THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA TO ACCEPT FISCAL YEAR 2007 GRANT FUNDS AND ADOPT THE 76TH AMENDMENT TO ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS RESOLUTION NO. 2007-214 APPROPRIATING \$25,000 FOR THE FRESNO POLICE DEPARTMENT'S CALIFORNIA CLICK IT OR TICKET PROGRAM (CIOT)

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the Chief of Police to enter into and execute the agreement and all related documents, with the Regents of the University of California, for the Fresno Police Department's 2008 California Click It or Ticket (CIOT) project and adopt the 76th Amendment to Annual Appropriation Resolution No. 2007-214 appropriating \$25,000 into the FY 08 budget.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The UC Berkeley Traffic Safety Center (TSC) is administering the Click It or Ticket (CIOT) program funds for the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS). CIOT's goal is to increase safety belt use statewide to 95% by July 31, 2008. Grant funding will be utilized to increase the level of seat belt enforcement hours, on an overtime basis, for first-line supervisors, officers, and administrative time for a 21-day period in May and June 2008, in support of the **Click It or Ticket** national mobilization. The CIOT grant is a reimbursable grant with reimbursements received after approval of claim reports.

KEY OBJECTIVE BALANCE

The CIOT grant program balances the three key objectives of prudent Financial Management, Employee Satisfaction, and Customer Satisfaction by utilizing grant funding to pay for overtime seatbelt enforcement operations, which will ultimately benefit the community by increasing traffic safety. It will provide Employee Satisfaction by allowing officers the opportunity to increase public safety through the **Click It or Ticket** seatbelt enforcement campaign.

BACKGROUND

The goal of the Click It or Ticket (CIOT) program is to increase safety belt use statewide to 95% by July 31, 2008. The COIT mini-grant will increase the Fresno Police Department's ability to deal with the issue of seat belt non-compliance. This is to be accomplished through the combined efforts of state and local law enforcement agencies in conducting a seat belt enforcement campaign for a 21-day period in May and June 2008, in support of the ***Click It or Ticket*** national mobilization.

The first agreement was approved by Council on October 29, 2002. Over the years, OTS has continued to make grant funding available to augment seat belt enforcement efforts and pay for associated overtime costs.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no impact to the general fund.
