

SUBJECT: Actions pertaining to the Shields and Temperance Avenues Intersection Signalization Project, Bid File 3319 (Council District 4)

1. Adopt finding of a Categorical Exemption pursuant to Class 1 Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines, for the Shields and Temperance Avenues Intersection Signalization Project
2. Award a construction contract to Lee Wilson Electric Company, Inc. of Arroyo Grande, CA in the amount of \$319,927.00 for the Shields and Temperance Avenues Intersection Signalization Project

RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff recommends that the City Council:

1. Adopt finding of a Categorical Exemption pursuant to Class 1 Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines, for the Shields and Temperance Avenues Intersection Signalization Project and,
2. Award a construction contract to Lee Wilson Electric Company, Inc. of Arroyo Grande, California in the amount of \$319,927.00 for the Shields and Temperance Avenues Intersection Signalization Project and to authorize the Public Works Director, or his designee, to sign and execute the standardized contract on behalf of the City.

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of Fresno will install traffic signals at the intersection of Shields and Temperance Avenues. The project will also install small quantities of pavement and concrete as well as install signage, striping, and modify existing median noses and pedestrian ramps. Staff recommends Council approve award of a construction contract to Lee Wilson Electric Company, Inc. Electric of Arroyo Grande, California in the amount of \$319,927.00 as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Shields and Temperance Avenues Intersection Signalization Project.

BACKGROUND

The intersection of Shields and Temperance Avenues has seen an increase in traffic congestion as a result of new subdivisions in the area. The purpose of the project is to address traffic congestion at the intersection by installing traffic signals. Additionally, the project will install small quantities of pavement and concrete sidewalk at the southwest corner of the intersection as well as install signage, striping and modify existing median noses and pedestrian ramps.

Construction documents and specifications were prepared and a Notice Inviting Bids was published in the Business Journal on April 14, 2014, and posted on the City's website as well as faxed to ten (10) building exchanges. Advertising efforts resulted in the participation of twenty six (26) prospective bidders. Ultimately, two (2) sealed bid proposals were received and opened in a public bid opening on May 6, 2014, with the bids ranging from \$319,927.00 to \$355,425.00. Lee Wilson Electric Company, Inc. of Arroyo Grande, California, submitted the lowest bid in the amount of \$319,927.00 and is considered the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The bid results were posted on May 15, 2014, on the City of Fresno Purchasing Division web page.

Staff is recommending award of a construction contract to Lee Wilson Electric Company, Inc. of Arroyo Grande, California in the amount of \$319,927.00 for the Shields and Temperance Avenues Intersection Signalization Project and to authorize the Public Works Director, or his designee, to sign and execute the standardized contract on behalf of the City.

ENVIRONMENTAL FINDINGS

Staff has performed a preliminary environmental assessment of this project and has determined that it falls within the Class 1 Categorical Exemption set forth in Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines which exempts the addition of safety or health protection devices for use during construction of or in conjunction with existing structures, facilities or mechanical equipment or topographical features including navigational devices. Additionally, the project involves the minor alteration of existing public structures, mechanical features and topographical features, with negligible expansion of use. Furthermore, Staff has determined that none of the exceptions to Categorical Exemptions set forth in the CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2 apply to this project. Staff recommends that the Council, based on its own independent judgment, adopt a finding of Categorical Exemption per staff determination, pursuant to Class 1 Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines for the Shields and Temperance Avenues Intersection Signalization project.

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LOCAL PREFERENCE


Local preference was not implemented based on funding conditions of the Proposition 1B State Local Partnership Program (SLPP).
