**CITY OF FRESNO
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO THE 2011-2012 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

Notice is hereby given to the general public on the City of Fresno's intent to amend the 2011-2012 Annual Action Plan. As a recipient of federal entitlement funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Development (HUD), the City is required to prepare a plan of action describing the distribution and proposed use of the federal funds to eligible activities during the program year. Additionally, if the proposed use of an activity changes the City is required to amend the document and notice the public.

FY 2011-2012 Annual Action Plan Amendment No. 1 proposes to reallocate \$48,000 of Community Development Block Grant funding from the Senior Meals Program to make improvements to the Romain Neighborhood Center located at 745 N. First Ave. The reduction of the \$48,000 in Senior Meal programming will be replaced with a grant from an outside agency providing support to seniors.

The Romain Neighborhood Center Rehabilitation Project proposes to use CDBG funds to:

- Kitchen – Remove and replace appliances and cabinets. Prepare walls; relocate electrical outlets and relocate plumbing for the sink.
- Recreation Room – Sand and seal the floor. Paint the room.
- Computer Lab – Relocate electrical and purchase computers.
- Court – Surfacing, basketball standards, volleyball posts and sleeves, and benches.

The FY 2011-2012 Annual Action Plan Substantial Amendment will be available for a 30-day review beginning January 13, 2011. The amendment can be viewed at City Hall 2600 Fresno Street, Fresno, CA in the City Clerk's Office (Room 2133); the Budget and Management Studies Division, 2440 Tulare Street, Suite 100; and the Fresno County Library (Downtown branch). The item will be presented to the Housing and Development Commission (HCDC) on February 8, 2012, at 5:00 p.m. The Fresno City Council will consider the amendment on February 23, 2012, at 8:30 a.m. Both meetings will be held at Fresno City Hall, 2600 Fresno Street, Second Floor, Fresno, CA. The City will provide interpreters upon request, and will make special accommodations for persons with disabilities.
