**Make It Creative**

Have students make signs, banners and posters to put up around school, in local businesses, community centers, libraries, faith centers, etc...

**Make It Festive**

Decorate bikes and helmets. Carry signs and balloons; give bike trains a parade appearance. Make sure nothing could get tangled in the moving parts of a bike or affect the fit of a helmet.

**Have a Contest! Make It a Game!**

**Decoration Contest**

Have posters or decorated bikes and helmets judged. Winners can be rewarded with prizes solicited from local business, and/or a picture of the winning bike and/or the winning poster could be published in the local paper. Invite a local official (the Mayor, Council Member, or Superintendent) or a TV news anchor or radio personality to serve as a celebrity judge.

**First Class**

The class with the most students participating could win a pizza party.

**Random Raffle**

Students who bike to school can be given raffle ticket and the winners can be drawn at random.

**Treasure Hunt**

Look for neighborhood "treasures." Do you pass a park? Do you pass a library; a fire station; or a store? Look for specific things or make a list of all of the reasons your school neighborhood is great.

**Study the Streets**

Draw your route to school or network of the streets.
