

# Bicycle Safety Tips



1. Always wear your **BIKE HELMET**. It is the LAW if you are under 18 years old.

*Highly recommended if you are 18 years old or older.*

2. Never dart out into a street.

3. Always listen to police officers, school officials, and crossing guards when they provide direction to cross a street.

4. Make sure that the vehicles on the street come to a stop before crossing in front of them.



5. When possible ride with adults or with other students to make yourself more visible to motorists.

*Hand signals. (Use left hand.)*

6. Always ride in the same direction of travel as traffic.



7. Make sure your bike has reflectors and at night use a white light in front.

8. Be extra cautious around school driveways.

9. Wear bright clothing when riding when it is dark.



10. Walk your bike across busy streets in the crosswalk.
