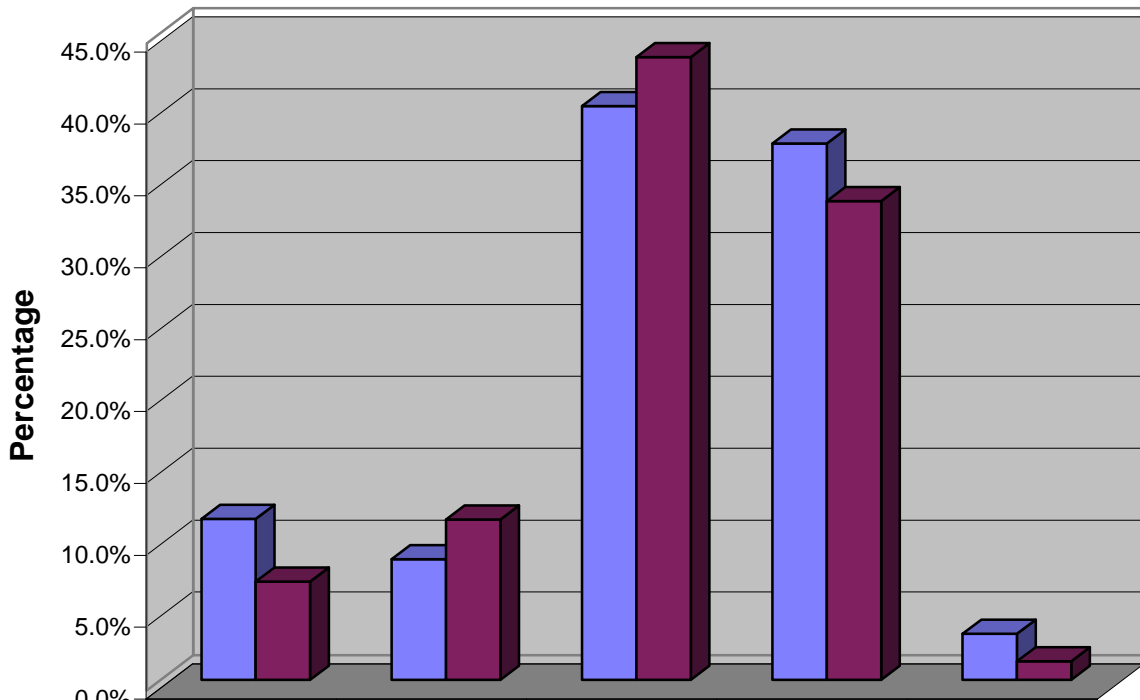

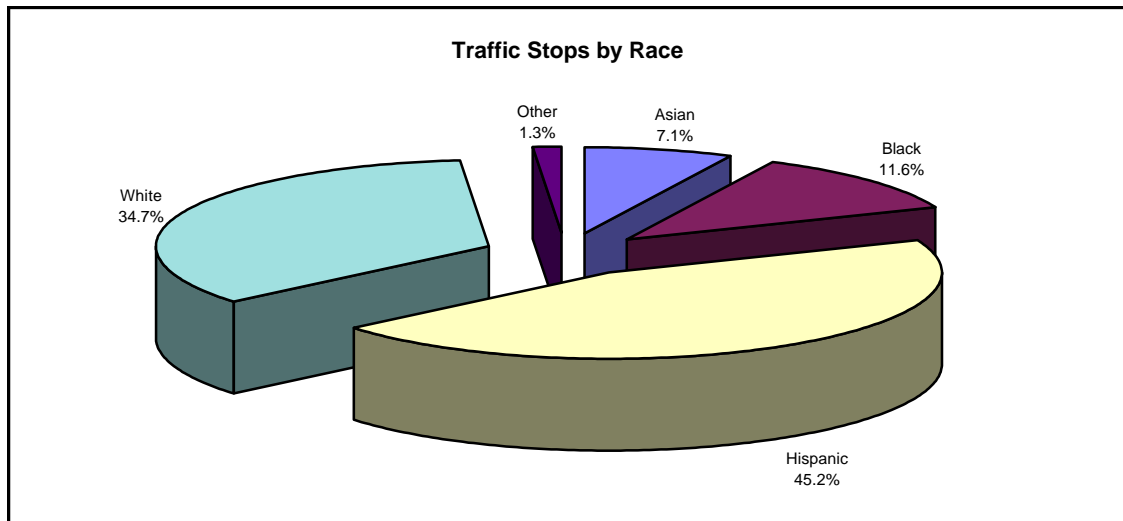
**% Population vs. % of Drivers Stopped by Race**

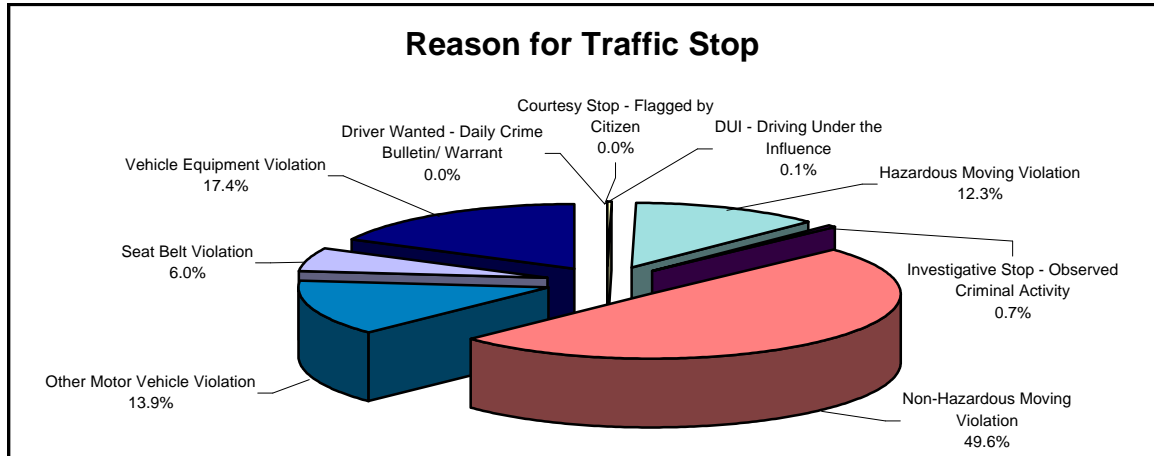

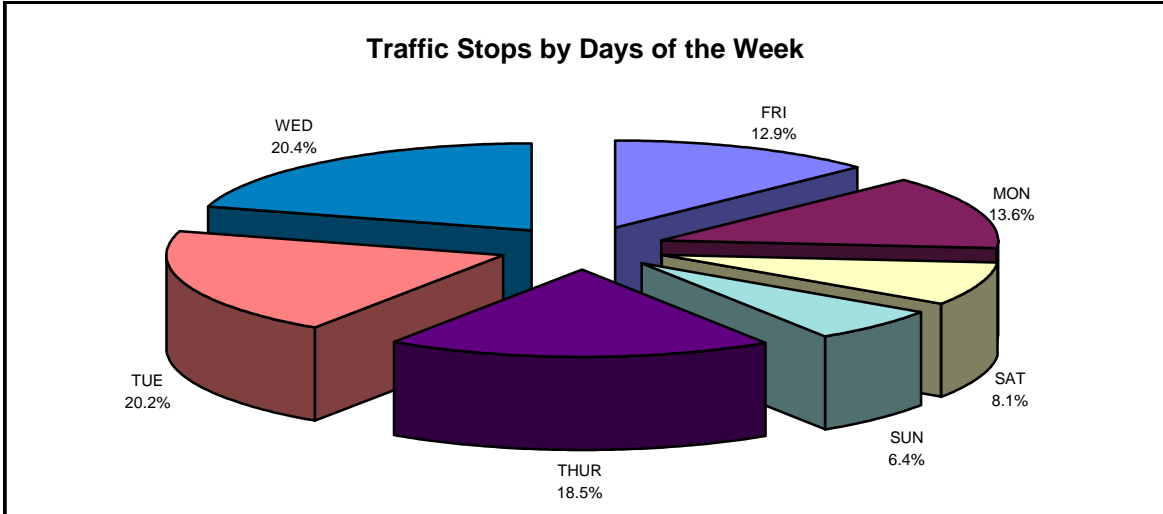

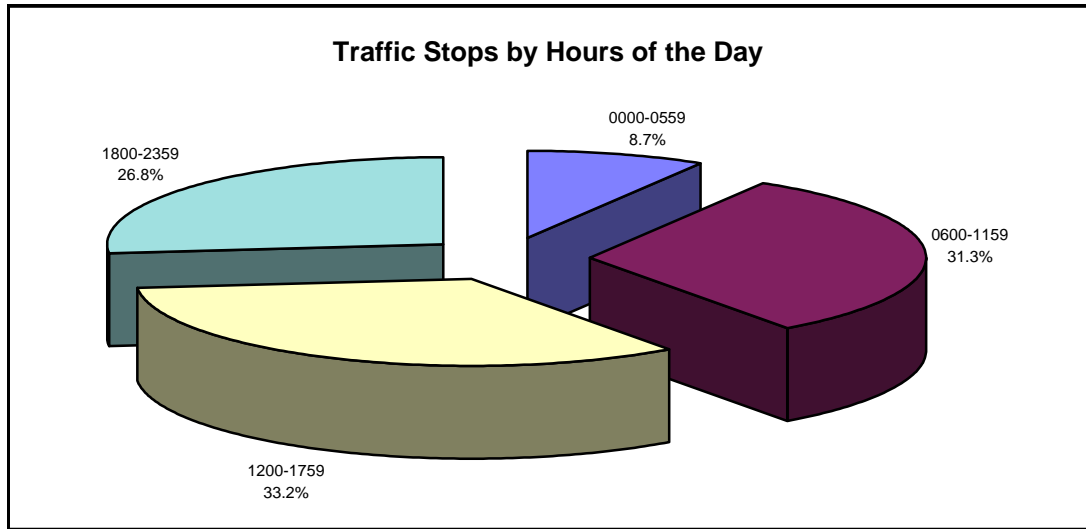

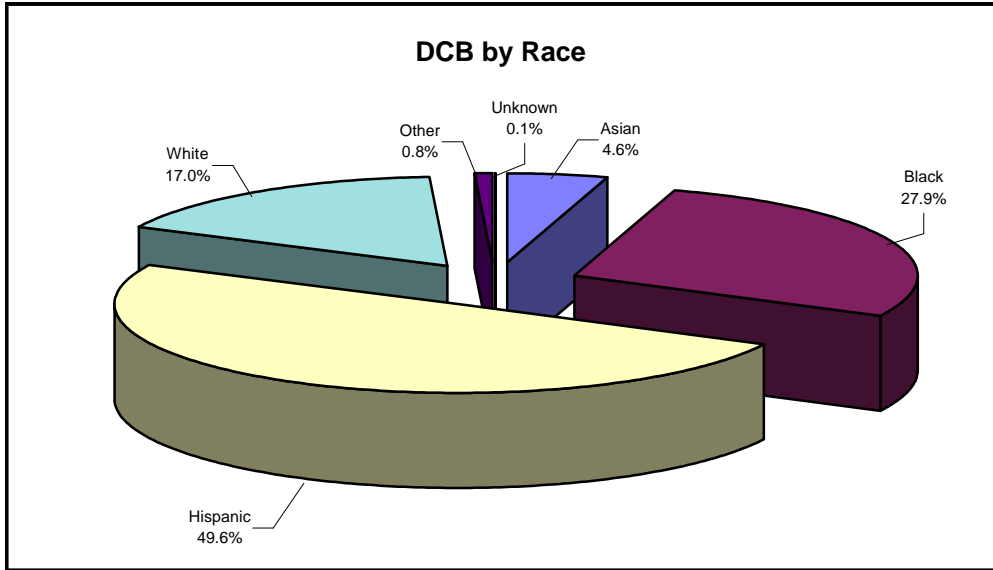
