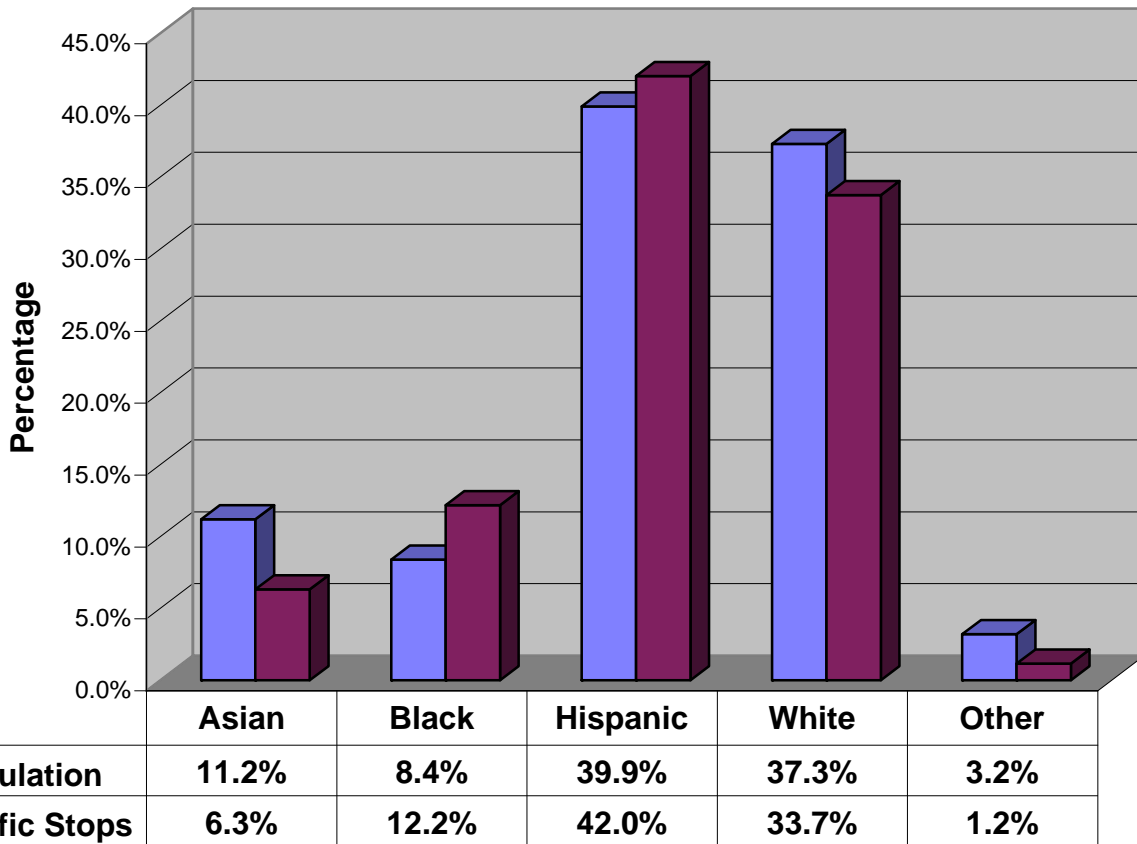

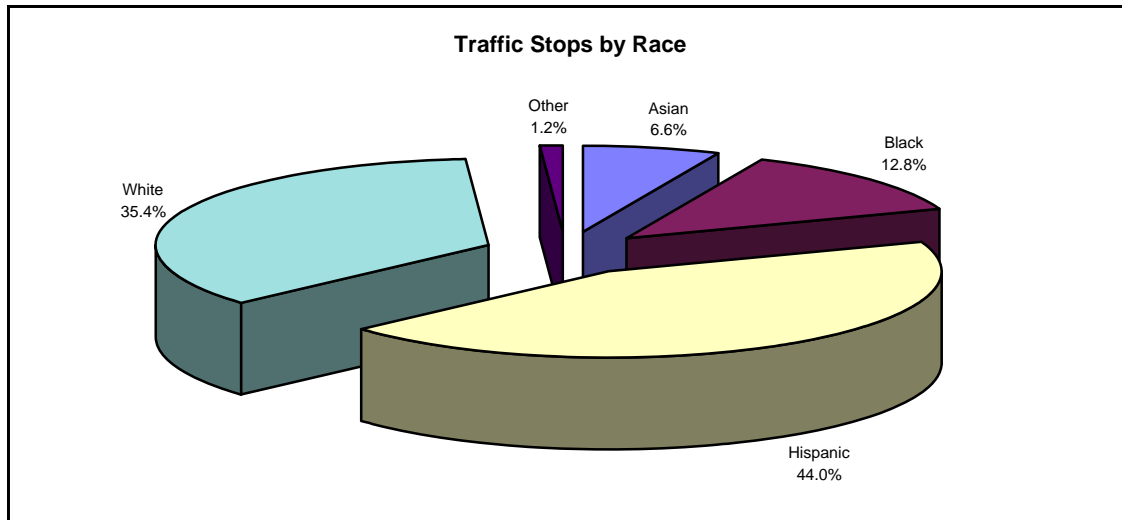

TRAFFIC STOPS BY RACE



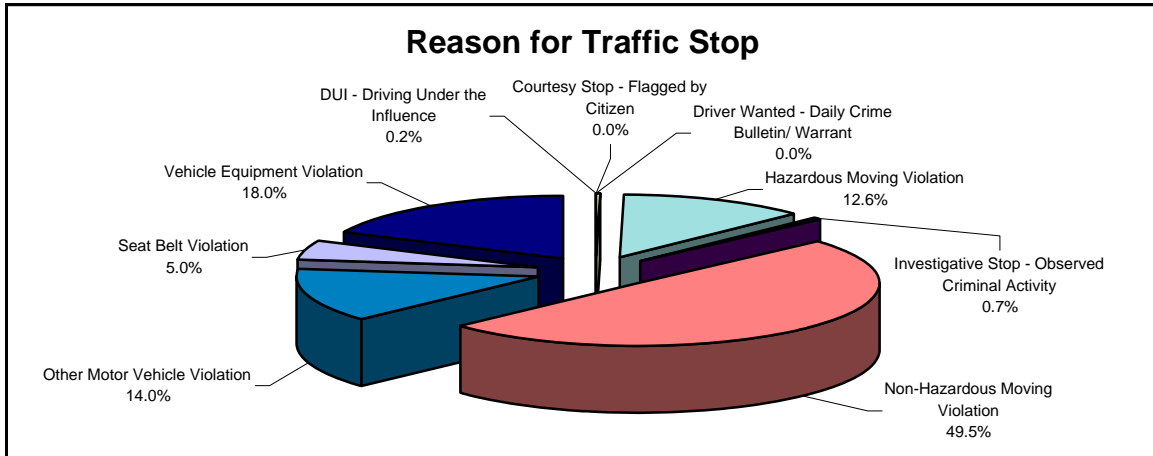

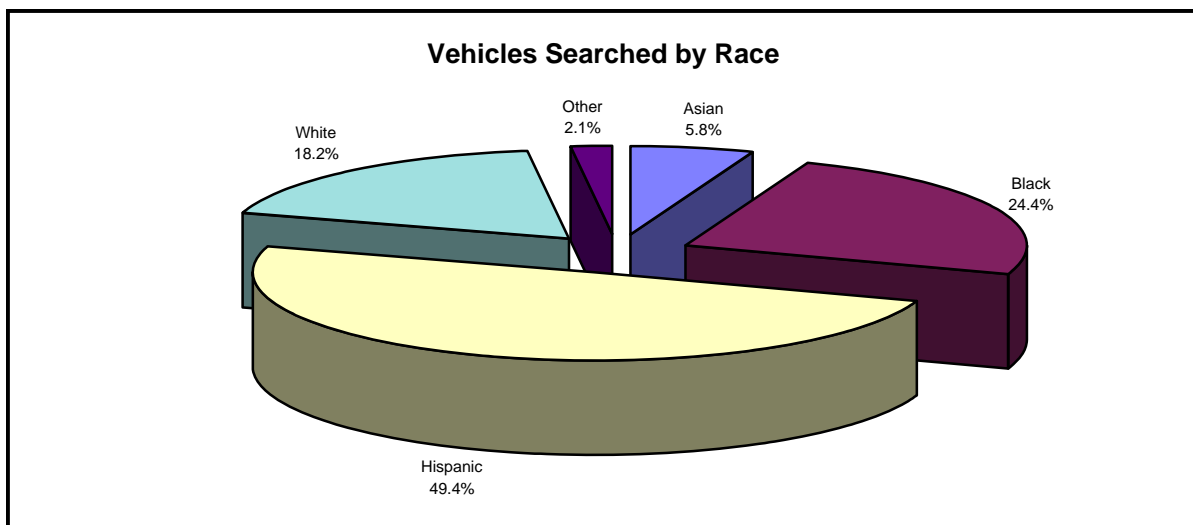

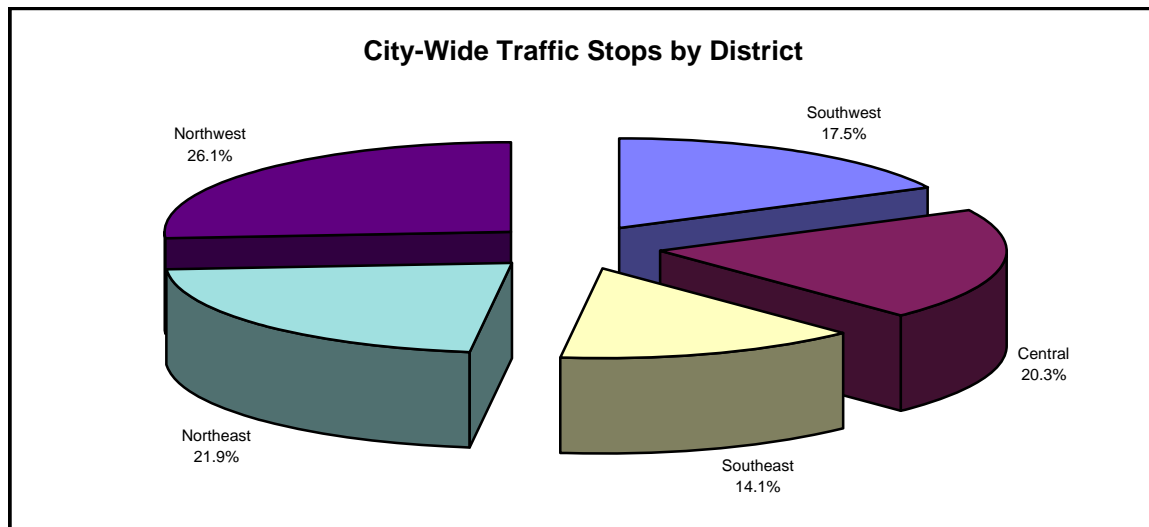

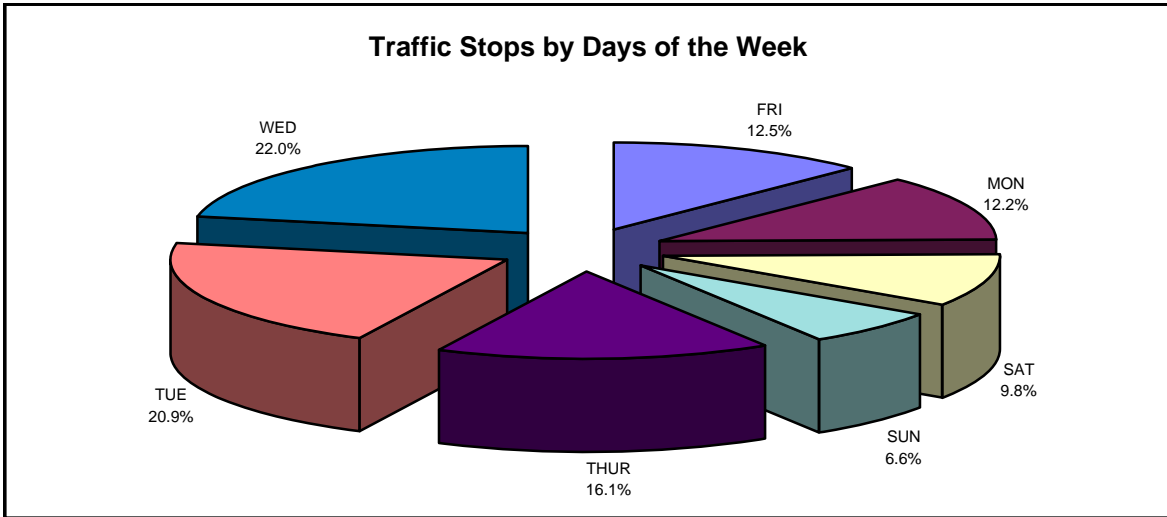

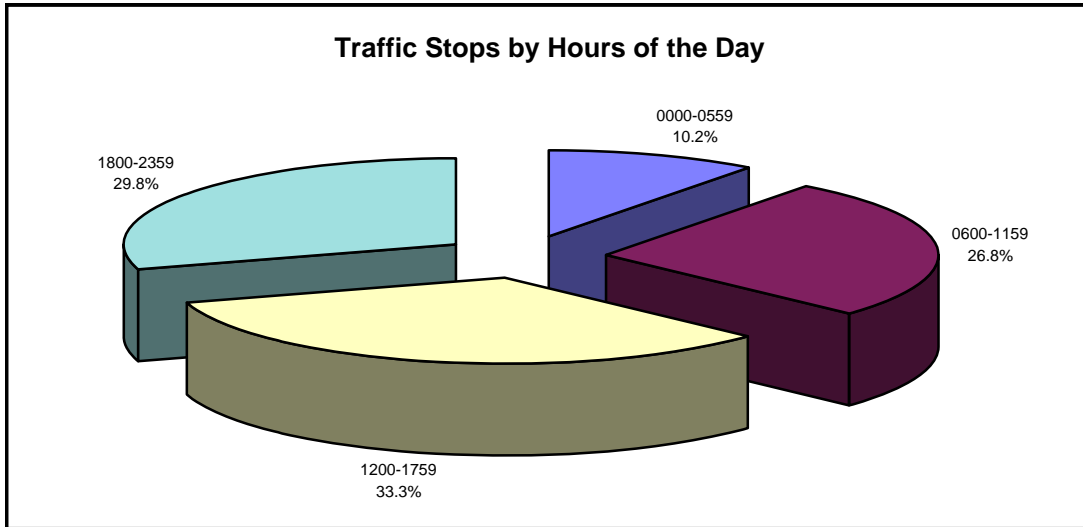

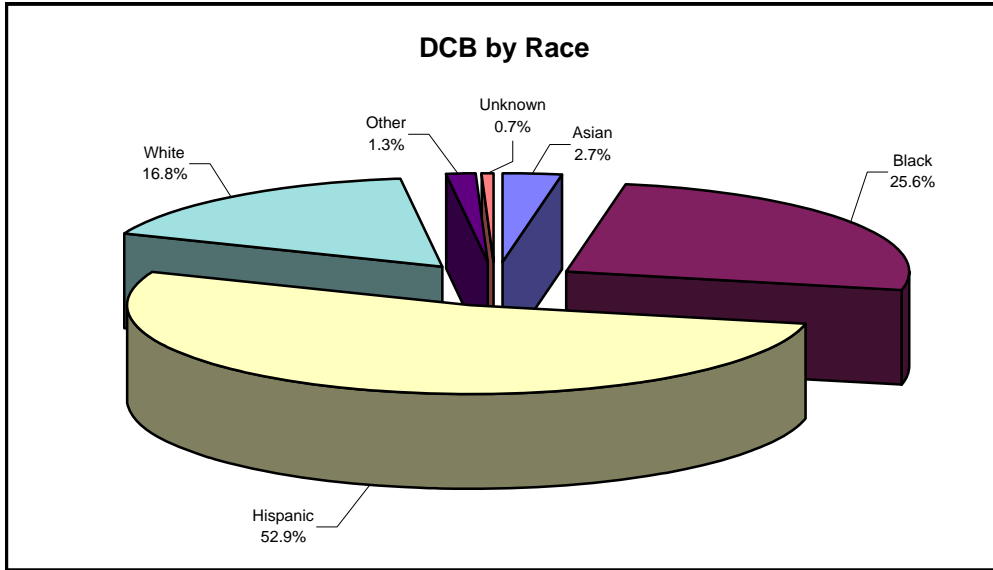
