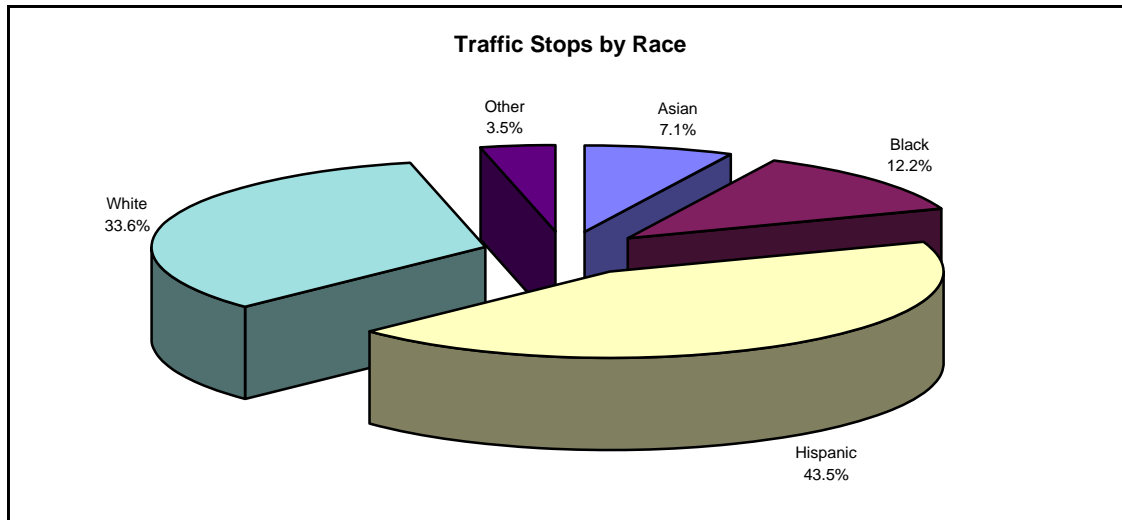

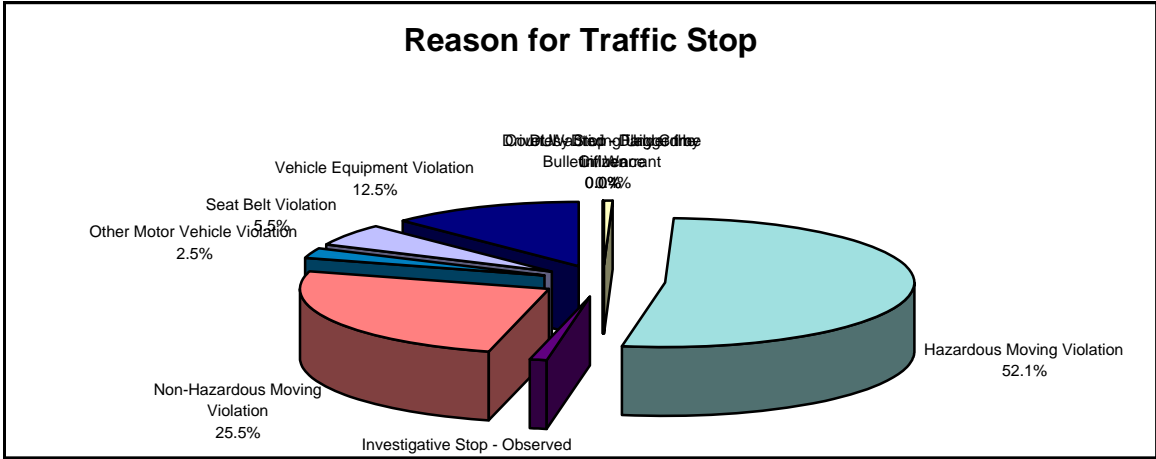

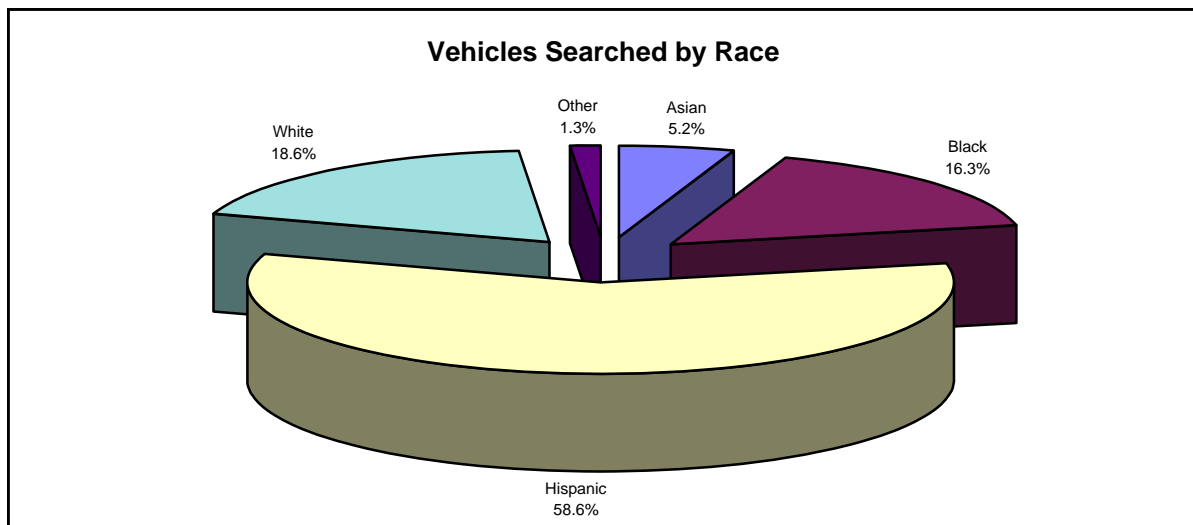

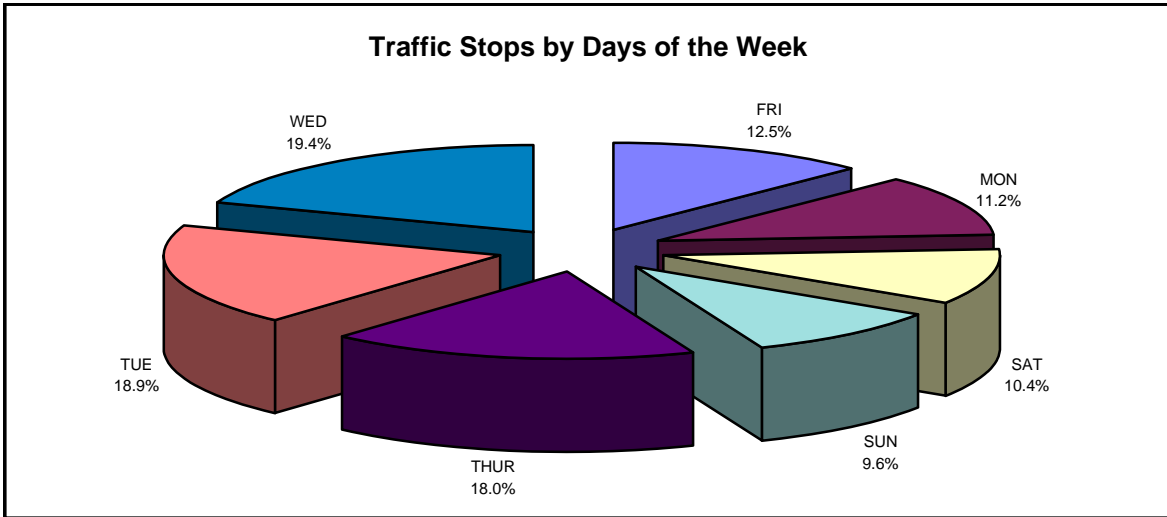

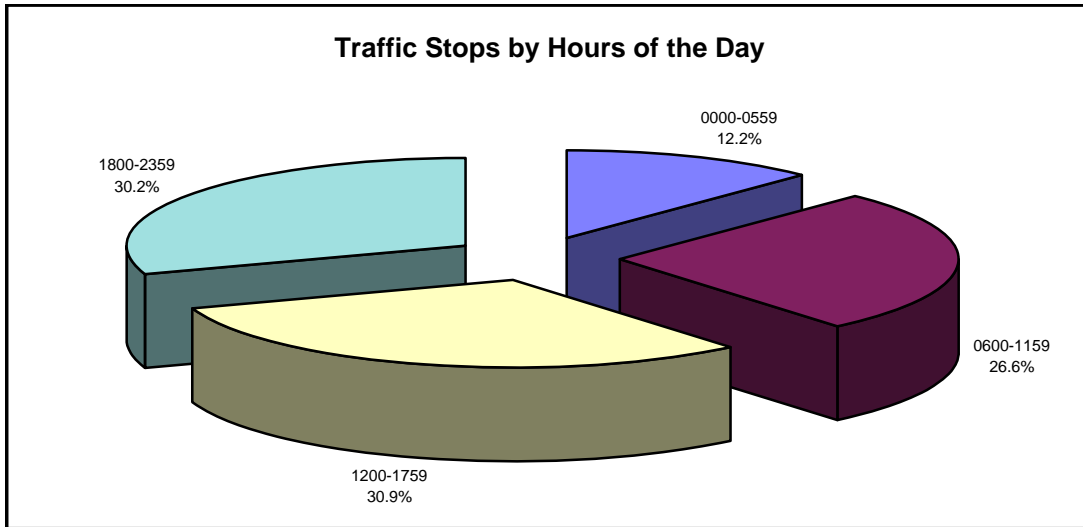
TRAFFIC STOPS BY DAYS OF THE WEEK CITY-WIDE

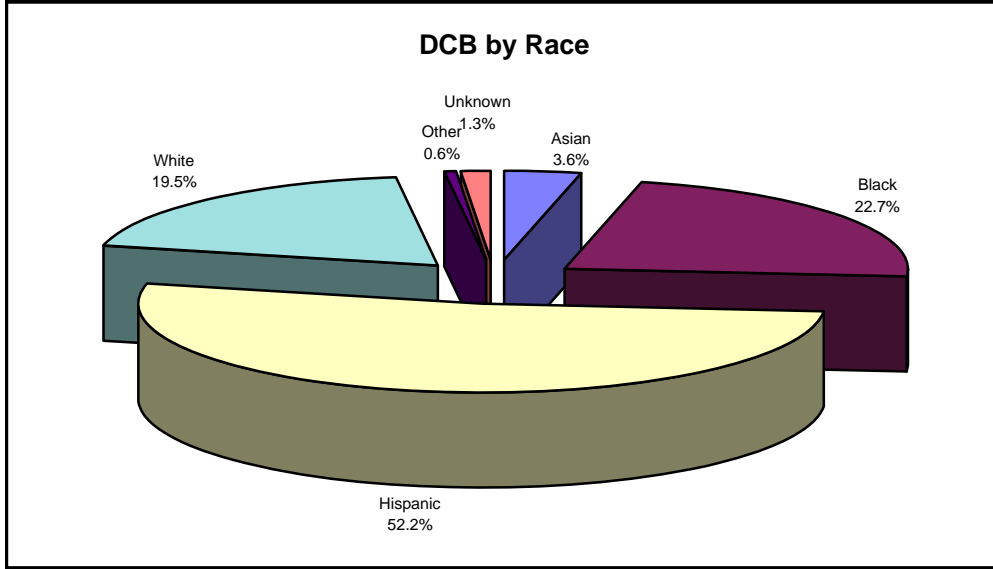
