COUNCILMEN BERGEAS AND BRAND TO ANNOUNCE CHARTER REFORM

Fresno, CA (September 21, 2010) – Councilmen Andreas Borgeas and Lee Brand will hold a press conference at City Hall tomorrow to announce the formation of a Charter Review Committee. The Fresno City Charter serves as the City’s constitution and provides the foundation for how the City of Fresno operates. It has been nearly twenty years since a committee pursuant the “Little Hoover Commission” made recommendations for changing the Fresno City Charter, and councilmen Borgeas and Brand are proposing that now is the appropriate time to form a commission to review how the City operates.

“With our fiscal constrains and organizational challenges, we are committed to streamlining City operations with high performance and accountability standards,” stated Councilman Borgeas. “Just as any business would review how it operates and functions, so should our City,” stated Councilman Lee Brand.

Councilmen Borgeas and Brand will reveal their plan and the specific charter issues to be addressed in more detail tomorrow at Fresno City Hall.
