2. How important is it that new communities in SEGA include street designs, landscaping, and open spaces that capture and treat stormwater?

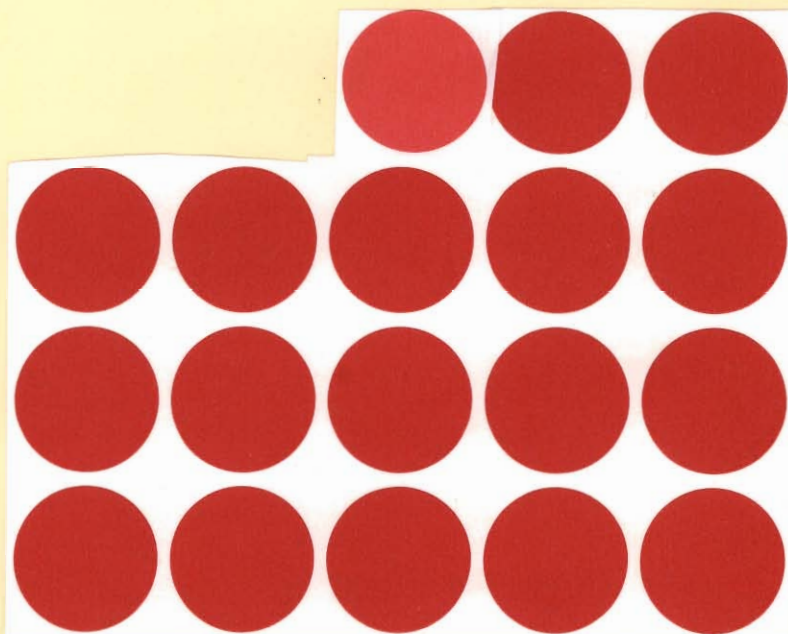
ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY
