SWIM
FRESNO

STEP #1: CHOOSE A SWIM CLASS that fits the participant's skill level and/or need

STARFISH

Water adjustment, personal water safety skills, comfort in the water, and working with others are emphasized

TADPOLES

Students are exposed to basic swimming skills, such as breath control, paddling, kicking, and floating

GOLDFISH

Improves tadpole skills and introduces buoyancy, body position, propulsion, and coordinated strokes

SHARKS

Increases swimmer's endurance, water safety skills and introduces swimmer to additional coordinated strokes

DOLPHINS

Coordination of movements in order to swim more smoothly, efficiently and for longer distances

PARENT-TOT

Water adjustment skills taught through the parent to the first-time and/or reluctant swimmer

JUNIOR LIFEGUARD

Four weeks of introduction to lifeguarding skills for youth 12-15 years old

SNORKELING

Learn snorkeling at Airways Pool. Must provide mask & fins and be at least 7 yrs. old

WATER EXERCISE

Stay in shape while your kids learn to swim at Mosqueda, Airways, and Frank H. Ball Pools. Contact Pool Manager

ADULT BEGINNER

Instructional swimming for adults

SENIOR AEROBICS

For older adults who may have limited mobility or arthritic conditions. Available at Mosqueda. Contact Pool Manager

SPECIAL NEEDS GROUPS

For youth and adult participants needing exposure to physical exercise and/or water adaptation

FOR SAFETY REASONS: If a child is not 3 feet tall **and** it presents a problem, a parent must accompany child in the water.
