- **Review and comment upon a draft Policy on Sidewalks**

The Planning and Development Department is formulating a policy on when sidewalks and walkways will be required in new developments in the City of Fresno. Our committee has been requested to review and comment upon this draft policy as we are an advisory committee on pedestrian as well as bicycle issues. This draft policy has already been reviewed by the city's Disability Advisory Commission, but that Commission has not yet taken a formal action. A copy of the draft policy is attached to this email. - **Presentation on Bus Rapid Transit**

John Downs of FAX will give a presentation on the city's efforts to bring Bus Rapid Transit to Fresno. The initial corridor for installation of BRT is along Ventura Avenue and Kings Canyon Road. Many of the bicycle advocates would like to see bicycle lanes along this corridor. There are at least two questions that bicyclists have regarding BRT--can bicycle lanes be installed along a BRT corridor and will bicycles be able to be taken on board these rapid buses?
