### **3. Presentation on the draft: Bikeways Plan Map**

### **5. Federal Funding for New Bikeways**

Staff presented a number of projects that they were anticipating taking to City Council for approval. This still needs administration approval.

### **6. Herndon Avenue Widening Project**

Bryan Jones presented a solution to address installation of a trail on the north side of Herndon Avenue between Marks Avenue and Brawley Avenue that could be submitted for a grant.
