2008 Call for Projects (CMAQ)

- City designated \$413,900.00 in Federal funds. (City of Fresno CMAQ Lifeline) for bike lanes
- Designated for Cedar Avenue Bike Lanes (Floradora to Los Altos)
- Schedule was PE in 10/11, CON in 11/12
- City submitted a BTA application for the same project and was successful
- Due to timing of the funds (CON 11/12), it was not yet time to designate a new project.
- COG recently required it to be designated on short notice as part of the 2011 FTIP
- City staff used the 2009 unfunded list and chose Gettysburg Bike Lanes from Blackstone to Winery (PE 09/10, CON 10/11)

2009 Call for Projects (CMAQ)

- City designated \$321,800.00 in Federal funds (City of Fresno CMAQ Lifeline) for bike lanes
- Designated for Millbrook Avenue Bike Lanes (Shields to Gettysburg)
- Schedule to be determined through work with COG on FTIP programming

As for your request, "possible involvement of the BPAC in selecting bike lane and trail projects for next fiscal year's CIP" the Capital Budget Requests were due already to budget. As we have discussed in the past, the City would like to wait to identify how we would spend our Measure C Bike Lane and Trail money until such time the following two items are completed; the prioritization of the Bicycle Master Plan projects and next year match requirements for all our grant projects. So what Scott Mozier and I have agreed to is that we can go back to City Council in September/October 2010 with an amended FY11 budget identifying the remaining amount of Measure C money and what projects we will work to design and construct for 2011. This will allow for dialogue between the City and BPAC later this spring and summer on potential projects and will not affect the timing or delivery of FY11 projects as we would not build them until the spring/summer/fall of 2011 anyway.
