

## **Fresno Area Express (FAX) - Senior 7 Program**

- The FAX Senior 7 program was made possible through the reauthorization of Measure C, Fresno County's one-half cent sales tax for transportation purposes.
- Seniors 65 years of age and over may ride any FAX fixed-route bus for free simply by showing a valid form of identification.
- FAX Senior 7 service is effective on any day, at any time, for any trip purpose.
- FAX issues free (optional) Senior 7 ID cards at the following locations:

### **Manchester Transit Center**

### **FAX Downtown Service Center**

## **FAX Silver Sundays Service**

- Seniors 62-64 may ride any FAX fixed-route bus for free on Sundays simply by showing a valid form of identification.

## **FAX Fixed-Route Senior Fares**

- Seniors 62-64 pay a reduced transit fare of 35¢ (regular fare is \$1.00).
- Seniors 62-64 may purchase a monthly pass for \$10.00 (regular pass costs \$35.00).

## **Council of Fresno County Governments Taxi Scrip Program**

- The Measure C funded Taxi Scrip program is available to Fresno County residents 70 years of age and over.
- Participants submit an eligibility application.

- Once approved, participants may purchase a \$20 value booklet of taxi scrip for \$5.
- Up to five (5) booklets of taxi scrip may be purchased each calendar month.
- Taxi Scrip may be used like cash to pay for taxi cab fares 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
