

Welcome to eComment

eComment comes to the City of Fresno

Constituents can now comment on upcoming agenda items via our website using eComment. To leave a comment users must click on eComments on our agenda page (<https://fresno.legistar.com/Calendar.aspx>), select the agenda you want to comment on, then select the item you wish to comment on and submit your written comment. eComment begins at 5pm on Friday prior to the Thursday Council meeting and closes at 9am on the Wednesday prior to the Thursday meeting. Comments are exported into a report and distributed to the Mayor, City Council, City Attorney, City Manager and Department Directors.

eComment Can Improve Meeting Participation

Due to work, school, and family commitments, constituents are not always able to attend City Council meetings. The eComment solution provides constituents an additional opportunity for participation when they cannot be at a City Council meeting in person. Using eComment allows any person, anywhere to leave a comment on an agenda item via the internet.

eComment is Transparent Government

eComment is also a valuable tool for staff. Significant staff time savings can be realized by encouraging constituents to post their comments using eComment as opposed to sending emails or leaving phone messages with City staff. Having a central repository for comments ensures that the City Council and City staff is in compliance with the Brown Act by having a transparent, predictable process for managing public comment.
