The “Coffee and Conversation Meeting” will be held at Café Van Ness located at 3204 N Van Ness Blvd in District 1. Councilmember Soria has committed to her communities that she will continue to be accessible and if the residents can’t come to City Hall, she will bring City Hall to the District 1 neighborhoods. Councilmember Soria and staff will be available to meet with residents to hear concerns as well as visions for the neighborhoods.

In the evening, Councilmember Soria and staff will be at Steinbeck Elementary School, 3550 N Milburn Ave., Fresno from 6:30 to 8:00pm for a Community Meeting. She will also have Northwest District Police Lt. Papaleo, Neighborhood Watch President Roz Clark, and Public Works Manager Del Estabrook to answer questions regarding Code Enforcement.

The Community recently experienced a senseless murder of one of their own. 9 year old Janessa Ramirez who attended Steinbeck Elementary School. The Councilmember along with the Police Department, Neighborhood Watch and Code Enforcement will be available to help the community heal and become strong again as they work together pushing back the crime and blight from their neighborhoods.
