(Fresno, CA)- Fresno City Council President Esmeralda Soria was one of sixty people selected from hundreds of applicants throughout the world to attend Harvard's John F. Kennedy School of Government, Executive Leadership Program. Councilwoman Soria is participating in a 3-week executive program for local elected officials, which provides hands-on learning, to help local officials improve how they serve their communities. The cost of the program is not paid for at tax payers expense, Councilwoman Soria, received a scholarship for the program.

“Ever since I was a little girl working in the fields of the Central Valley, it has been a dream to attend an Ivy League school, and I'm excited it's Harvard,” said Councilwoman Esmeralda Soria. “Harvard will give me an opportunity to sharpen my skills, and develop tools to better serve District 1, and the City of Fresno, as an effective policy maker.”
