2. Understand your PG&E account information


Knowing how you use energy and understanding your rate plan can help you manage costs

A no-cost/low-cost program designed to help YOU save money! Schedule a FREE in-home energy assessment and receive no-cost upgrades (can include heating/cooling updates, LED lightbulbs, low-flow shower heads, smart thermostats, duct sealant), estimates for low-cost upgrades, and monthly energy reports to help you stay on track. Energy Savings Assistance Program

Administered by PG&E & CPUC

Provides income-qualified residents free energy efficiency upgrades!
