FRESNO, CA – Councilmember Esmeralda Soria will be hosting District 1 Community Health Day events in partnership with USCF’s Mobile HEAL program and Neighborhood Industries’ Fresno CARES food distribution program to provide no-cost Covid-19 testing, free groceries, and free flu shots to the community.

The first Community Health Day event will be held at Williams Elementary School (525 W Saginaw Way, Fresno, CA) from 8am – 12pm on Saturday, October 10th. The second event will be held at the Sikh Institute-Fresno (4827 N Parkway, Fresno, CA) from 8am – 12pm on Saturday, October 17th.

Residents do not need to pre-register for the free groceries or free flu-shots. A free facemask will also be provided with groceries.
