On Tuesday, June 16, 2020, at the FY2021 Budget Meeting, Councilmember Esparza requested the following information:

**59) Request PARCS provide a memo with a status update regarding the basketball mural(s) at Martin Ray Reilly Park.**

D7 approached the PARCS Department seeking authorization to paint a mural on the basketball courts at Martin Ray Reilly Park. At the February 2020 coordination meeting with D7 and PARCS staff, it was agreed that Council was going to lead community engagement for soliciting input in selecting a final design. Preliminary timeline for the project was scheduled to occur in Fall of 2021 (Fall provides the ideal climate/ weather conditions). PARCS does not have funding for this request.
