COUNCIL DIRECTION NO. 71 – Fountain Way (Cedar and Shields) Paving  
Update

On June 18, 2020, Councilmember Caprioglio requested a status update for the Cedar/Shields/Fountain Way neighborhood repaving project.

The project is planned for completion by October 2020 and was included in the SB1 resolution adopted by the Council on June 11, 2020. Although General Fund resources were originally allocated to this project through Council action in March 2020, it is not anticipated that the General Fund will have sufficient resources to fund this project in FY2021. As such the Council-adopted SB1 resolution provides for the ability to repave the neighborhood using SB1 revenues and complete the work by October 2020.
