The brother and others in the residence blocked the door so the male could not enter. Additional Officers arrived and the male again approached the officers while armed with the knife. Officers continued to try and talk to the male as he approached. Officers fired multiple less than lethal bean bag like rounds at the male with little effect. An officer attempted to use a Taser, but the use was not successful. The male started running back toward the residence, away from the initial group of officers. An additional officer had arrived in the front yard of the residence. The male ran toward this officer in an aggressive manner while still holding the knife. This officer fired 5 rounds from his Department handgun, which caused the male to fall to the ground. Officers provided aid to the male, he was transported to the hospital where he was later pronounced deceased.</p>

									<p>An anonymous caller reported an agitated male who appeared to be homeless outside of a liquor store. The caller reported the male pulled a gun on another male outside of the store. While officers were enroute to the location the caller reported the male "put the gun back" and walked toward a nearby food truck. An FPD sergeant arrived and saw the male standing in the roadway. As the sergeant made a u-turn to contact the male, he saw the male gesturing to another male nearby as if he wanted to fight. The sergeant contacted the male and saw that he had a handgun tucked into the front of his waistband. The sergeant gave commands not to reach for the gun and to get on the ground. A second officer arrived and both the sergeant and the officer gave additional commands. The male did not do as he was instructed. The male placed his hands over his abdomen and lowered them toward the handgun. The officer fired one shot and struck the male in the hand. The male instantly complied. Officers handcuffed him and removed a replica firearm from his waistband. The male was treated for his injuries and charged with brandishing.</p>

The suspect continued to advance toward the officers and the officers believed he was armed with a handgun. Based on the actions of the suspect and fear for their safety, the two officers fired their issued firearms at the suspect (5 rounds from a handgun and 2 rounds from a shotgun). The suspect was struck with gunfire once in the right arm and twice in the lower extremities and was taken into custody. It was discovered the object in the suspect's hand was a cell phone. The suspect was treated at the hospital for non-life threatening injuries and later released with a citation for resisting and delaying officers.
