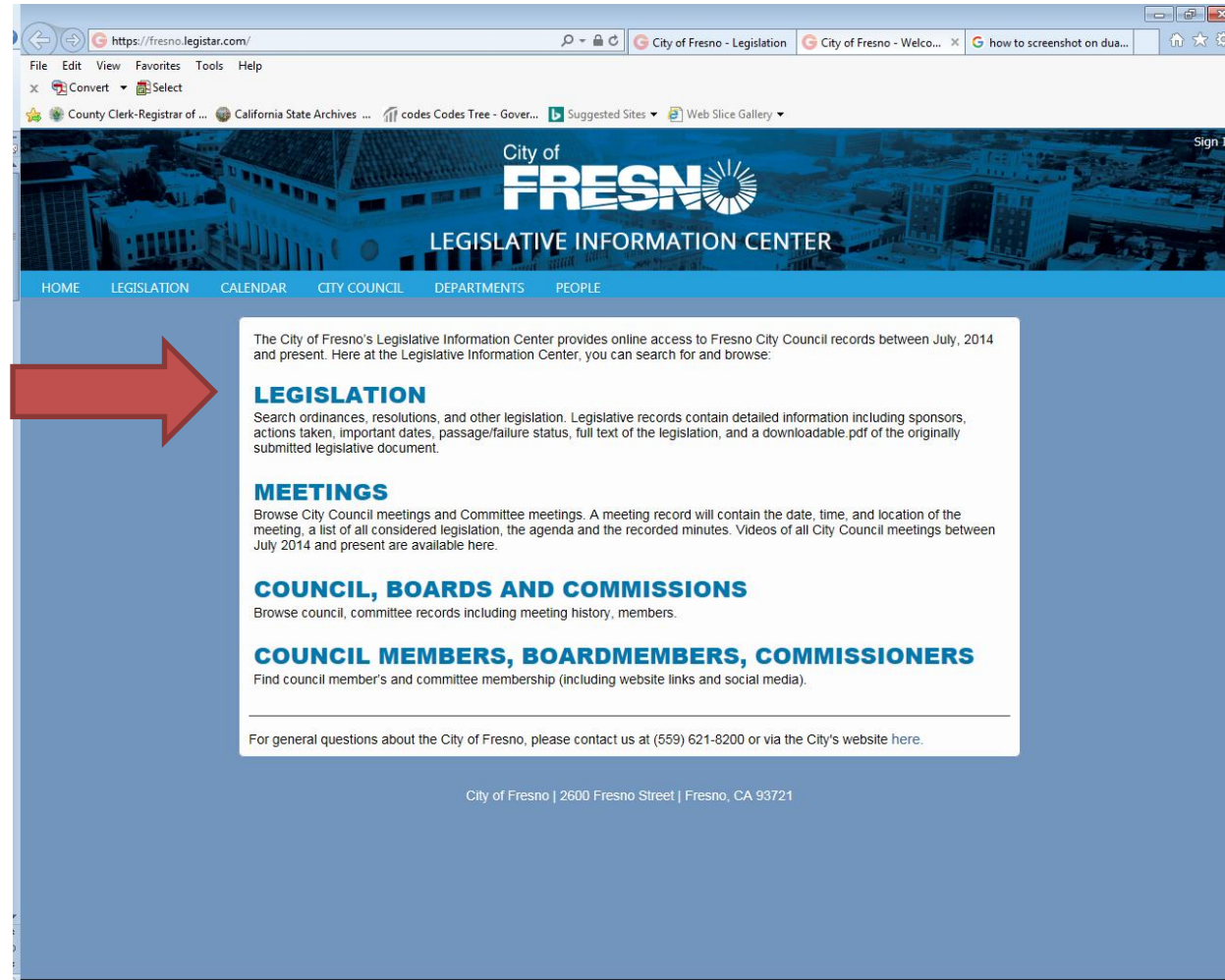


Searching in Legistar:

Click on Legislation:
