In December 1999, a new CAD/RMS system was brought in which did not accurately capture DER larceny counts, resulting in a lower than normal larceny count. It was discovered that the new RMS/CAD system resulted in several months [2] A preliminary report was released to the PIO in February 2002. This report reflected 421,568 CFS for 2001. Further analysis revealed this information was derived using a Data911 internal report which included not only unique police events, but also fire events. [16] FPD district boundaries were revised & implemented on January 1, 2009. [17] Due to software conversion, arson counts were added to the Index Total imitating the numbers for years 2005 - 2008. Adjustments were made to correct sub-totals. [18] FPD district boundaries were revised & implemented on January 1, 2011, going from five districts to four. [19] Due to transition from paper copy report to automated reports 2 Justifiable homicide count were under reported for the year of 2010 and 2011. Adjustments were made in house but FBI counts will remain the same.
