

[14] FPD reorganization: CVU was established on January 15, 2007 under Sergeant Tom Rowe. [15] Jan - Jun 2007 e-Reports (larcenies) were all added to July's counts. [16] FPD district boundaries were revised & implemented on January 1, 2009. [17] Due to software conversion, arson counts were added to the Index Total inflating the numbers for years 2005 - 2008. Adjustments were made to correct sub-totals. [18] FPD district boundaries were revised & implemented on January 1, 2011, going from five districts to four. (19) Due to Transition from paper copy report to automated reports. 2 Justinable nomicide count were under reported for the year of 2010 and 2011. Adjustments were made in house but FBI counts will remains the same. (20) In January 2015, the definition of Sexual Assault changed from gender based (male on female) to any non-gender nonconsensual sexual assault. Those specific numbers are available on the 2015 UCR Return-A's submitted to DOJ. In December (21) in October 2016, the districts were re-aligned to add Central to the FPD district boundaries.
