

It was discovered that the new RMS/CAD system resulted in several months of duplicate values. These duplicate values inflated the crime statistics and our vendor was required to [2] A preliminary report was released to the PIO in February 2002. This report reflected 2/1,568 CFS for 2001. Further analysis revealed this information was derived using a Data911 internal repor which included not only unique police events, but also fire events. program, National Fire Incident Reporting Systems (NFIRS), and not all records have been imported at this time.

[6] The number of homicides reported included one more than actually occurred in 2004. The difference was due to an unreported death from April 2003 that was reclassified in February 2004 to a homicide as a result of improved forensic findings.
