New Wireless Telecommunications Facilities Submittal Requirements Checklist

Please ensure all items listed below are provided on all plans and documents uploaded to the <u>Citizen's Access</u> Portal. - 1.) If your plans and documents do not contain the information listed below, your application will be deemed incomplete.
- 2.) Per the City of Fresno Interim Wireless Telecommunications Facilities Policy and Procedure C-010, new monopoles will not be permitted. All new wireless communications facilities proposed for installation of a base station with tower shall be a mono-tree with collocation abilities.

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New Facilities: 150 days upon submission of an application.

Tolling of review timeframe: To toll the timeframe for incompleteness, the City must provide written notice to the applicant within 30 days of receipt of the application for a new facility, and within 10 days of any subsequent re-submittal(s). The City will inform the applicant of missing documentation or information needed in relation to the project.

Preliminary Title Report or Grant Deed showing property ownership. (The Title Report
shall be prepared within 30 days of submittal of the application; includes legal description)
Letter of Owner Authorization (If Owner is not the Applicant). A lease agreement is not sufficient. All approvals will be contingent on the property where the lease area is located must comply with the Fresno Municipal Code and all existing entitlement applications. When the owner is signing this authorization, the owner is agreeing to these terms.
Photo Simulations from at least 2 different directions showing the current view and proposed view.
Coverage Maps: Maps showing the existing coverage and coverage to be gained with
the new tower.
Shadow Analysis: Per Section 15-2509 of the Fresno Municipal Code:
A. When a structure will exceed 50 feet in height, the developer must submit an analysis of

- A. When a structure will exceed 50 feet in height, the developer must submit an analysis of the shadows that the structure will cast on planned or existing residential property.
- 1. The shadow analysis should demonstrate the maximum extent of the shadows cast by a building through at least the four quarters of the year, between one hour after sunrise and one hour before sunset.
- 2. If the analysis indicates that the project shadow does not reach or significantly impact any residential properties, no further review of the project shadow will be required. However, if there is indication that the shadow would significantly impact residential properties, alternative designs or other mitigation measures shall be presented.

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Noise Analysis: Per Section 15-2506 of the Fresno Municipal Code, an acoustic study shall
be required for any proposed project which could create or be subject to noise exposure in
excess of the standards outlined in Section 15-2506. The noise assessment shall be
prepared by a qualified third-party consultant.
Federal Communications Commission Compliance: Documentation showing the
proposed technology for the tower will comply with all FCC guidelines and regulations.

less than 24 inches. The design, number and placement of any branch-like structures
affixed to the slim line monopole shall insure the adequate camouflaging of the antennas,
related electrical cables and equipment, and the antenna and equipment mounts."
 Note On Plans: "Socks matching the color and texture of the foliage are required for all
antenna and other equipment mounted on the mono-tree."
 Note On Plans: "Due to environmental factors such as wind, rain and sun, the owner /
applicant shall maintain all mono-trees to ensure that the faux foliage is lush, continues to
resemble a tree, and fully screens all antennas and other equipment."
 Note On Plans: "The owner/applicant shall maintain the fence / wall and ensure the fence /
wall is kept free of graffiti and vandalism, and any visible structural damage."
