Purpose of the Scoping Meeting

Provide first opportunity for public participation in the overall California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) process for the EIR.

• Allow the public to identify environmental issues to be analyzed in the EIR.

Environmental Impact Report (EIR)


- The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) is the State's primary environmental protection law.
- CEQA requires that public agencies disclose the potential environmental impacts of projects that have a physical effect on the environment.
- The CEQA document identifies way to avoid or lessen potential environmental impacts by incorporating mitigation measures or analyzing alternatives to the proposed project.

Project Overview


- 48.03 ac. project site at 2740 W. Nielsen on northeast corner of N. Marks and W. Nielsen Avenues
- Four office/warehouse buildings that would be configured for heavy industrial uses totaling 901,438 square feet
- Future tenants have not yet been identified



Project Overview

- A total of 594 on-site parking spaces would be provided for vehicles and trucks/trailers
- The project would also include a total of 201 loading dock doors
- Construction of the proposed project is anticipated to occur
 in two phases occurring over a total 24-month period
 starting in the third quarter of 2023 and ending in 2025
- Project would require: Development Permit and Tentative Parcel Map
