 - <u>S-15-004 250 East Belmont Ave.</u> Jeff Cazaly on behalf of Producers Dairy proposes to construct a 5,000 square foot two-story building (blow mold machinery on 1st floor, bottle storage on 2nd floor) and a 1,600 square foot addition to an existing bottling building. No additions to dock loading doors or employees are proposed. Zoning is split between C-6 (Heavy Commercial) and C-M (Commercial and Light Manufacturing) districts.
 - <u>C-14-158 1001-1011 N. Blackstone Ave.</u> Jamie Steinmetz of Paul Halajian Architects, for Sabrina Famellos of Anzula Luxury Fibers, proposes a mixed use project with renovations to an existing 2-story commercial building for 2 residences on the 2nd floor and yarn dying on the 1st floor.
 - <u>C-14-154 308 E. Olive Ave.</u> Thomas Tan for 'Opportunities for Learning' proposes to use an existing 4,000 square foot commercial building zoned C-5, for an independent study learning center. The school will serve grades 7 to 12 who will attend for two, 1.5-hour appointments per week, weekdays and some Saturdays from 8 am to 5 pm, closed for lunch between 12 to 1 pm.
 - 1420 E. Englewood Ave. Proposed new 12'x20' carport in rear yard to replace garage destroyed by fire.
