(no decorations or wires)
- Christmas Trees
(no decorations)

- Ribbons and Bows (try to reuse)
- Gift Wrap with Foil or Glitter

- Wrapping Paper
(no foil or glitter)
- Gift Tissue Paper
- Boxes (flattened)
- Holiday Cards
