The purpose of these Ground Rules is to provide a collegial and collaborative environment to facilitate information sharing and an opportunity to identify areas of common agreement, as well as provide for a calm and productive discussion of those areas where they may be disagreement.

- 1. All members of the committee are valued for their ideas and opinions.
- 2. Members will listen collaboratively to differing points of view.
- 3. Members will not interrupt each other during discussion.
- 4. Members will not devalue differing opinions.

Constructive Decision Making

- 1. The committee will first each provide an opening statement of no more than two minutes on their goal for the discussion.
- 2. The committee will discuss each area of the plan (Vision, Principles, Policies, Land Use) with an opportunity for each member to state their concurrence with the information and/or their recommendations for edits, deletions, and additions.
- 3. Committee members will be respectful of time and not repeat information that has already been presented.
- Committee members should strive to identify areas of common agreement and then move on to items which need more discussion.
- 5. The committee will make recommendations either in totality or item by item through simple majority vote of the voting members.
