

GRAFFITI ABATEMENT TECHNICIAN

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, performs a variety of duties involved in graffiti preventative measures and the removal of graffiti from structures, properties, and alleyways; operates light equipment.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED/EXERCISED

Receives supervision from the Division Manager. Exercises no supervision.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Graffiti Abatement Technician performs both routine and heavy physical work in the various methods of graffiti abatement, to include painting or paint removal utilizing pressure washer equipment.

EXAMPLES OF IMPORTANT AND ESSENTIAL DUTIES

May include, but are not limited to, the following:

Removes graffiti from various structures and private properties by washing or utilizing water blasting, painting, or other methods, including the use of graffiti removal chemicals; and seals and protects City infrastructures against graffiti damage.

Independently and proactively responds to requests for graffiti removal from citizens and/or other departments.

Works collaboratively with private property owners prior to graffiti removal if paint color is not available.

Locates graffiti using street guides and maps.

Records and logs daily graffiti removal activities; maintains records and prepares reports as necessary.

Photographs the scene of graffiti and documents the location.

Operates a variety of equipment; such as, pressure washers, free sprayers, paint trailer units and boom lifts; cleans spraying equipment and other related equipment used in graffiti removal.

Cleans, fuels, and prepares City vehicles and equipment for operation; performs minor repairs as necessary.

Sets up traffic control as needed and other means to ensure a safe work area.

May clean, disinfect and pressure wash public sidewalks/areas as needed.

May participate in community clean-up activities.

Performs other duties as assigned.

JOB RELATED AND ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

The geographic layout of the City of Fresno.

Graffiti removal procedures and techniques.

Chemical solvents used to remove graffiti.

Safe work practices.

Practices, tools and materials involved in the operation and maintenance of the infiltration disposal systems.

Skills to:

Operate a motor vehicle safely.

Operate and maintain a wide variety of graffiti removal equipment and painting supplies.

Ability to:

Perform light and heavy manual labor for extended periods and under adverse weather conditions.

Read and interpret street signs and maps in order to locate areas of work assignments.

Understand and follow written and oral instructions.

Read and write English at the level necessary to perform the job.

Maintain accurate records and reports.

Establish, maintain, and foster positive and harmonious working relationships with those contacted in the course of work.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Possession of a high school diploma or GED;

AND

Two (2) years of experience operating painting, pressure washing, or light equipment which includes a minimum of one (1) year of public contact.

Special Requirement(s):

Possession and maintenance of a valid Class 'C' California Driver's License required.
