

Operation Clean Up (OCU) Guidelines



BE ADVISED

- Do not place items out sooner than 7 days before your scheduled pickup date.
- OCU limit is two pickup loads with each load measuring about (8’ X 4’ X 4’)
- Residents will be held accountable for any dangerous conditions caused by the size, placement, or any hazardous material in their debris pile (FMC 15-2514).
- Illegal dumping is subject to citation up to three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) plus three times the city’s costs to abate the violation if the city is required to abate the violation. SEC. 10-611. - UNLAWFUL DUMPING.

OCU GUIDELINES

- Items shall be out by 6:00 A.M. on the scheduled day of pick up
- Move all vehicles away from debris piles (THIS WILL PREVENT PICK UP)
- Discards must be placed 1-1.5 feet from the curb in front of your residence, and away from sewer vents, water meters, mailboxes, and fire hydrants to avoid potential property damage.
- Keep discards 4-5 feet away from speed bumps.
- Concrete, brick, rock, or dirt is limited to two wheelbarrows
- Place items where weekly residential garbage containers are serviced, except those having alley services
- **NO ALLEY SERVICE for OCU**
- Separate green waste from debris pile
- Tape windows and mirrors with duct tape to minimize glass debris

The Following Items Are NOT Accepted

- **NO refrigerators, freezers, or A/C Units**
- **NO construction or remodeling debris**
- **NO major landscape work or tree removal**
- NO tree stumps, trunks, or rounds
- NO items, such as lumber, branches, pipes, beams, etc., longer than 4 feet in length
- NO household garbage or home business generated garbage (USE GRAY TRASH CART)
- NO fifty gallon drums
- NO electronics, televisions, monitors, computers, etc.
- NO tires - Contact Code Enforcement Division at (559) 621-8400 for information
- NO paint - Contact Paint Care at (855) PAINT09 or (855) 724-6809 for information
- NO explosive material and/or ammunition - Contact Fresno PD (Non-Emergency (559) 621-7000)
- NO automotive fluids or parts
- NO used creosote treated railroad ties
