- City of Fresno Local Housing Trust Fund (LHTF) established in 2021
- A savings account for local housing needs
 - Access to decent, safe, and affordable housing within the City of Fresno
- Receives up to \$1,500,000 million per year via real estate transfer tax



Eligible Activities

- Loans for Construction & Rehabilitation for:
 - Affordable homebuyer/homeowner projects
 - Emergency Shelters
 - Permanent Supportive Housing
 - Transitional Housing
 - Accessory Dwelling Units
- Downpayment Assistance to qualified first-time homebuyers
- Rehabilitation of homes owned by income-eligible homeowners.









Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)

NOFA released March 6, 2023 – April 17, 2023

- Purpose: New construction of Affordable Rental Housing Development
 - Households with average incomes of no more than 60% Area Median Income (AMI) with a minimum of 30% units of supporting households with an average income of no more than 30% AMI
 - 55-year affordability period
- Notification released on Social Media (Facebook, Twitter), City of Fresno website,
 Planet Bids, The Business Journal
- Received 8 responding applications


Avalon Commons Phase II

- Project award date: May 11, 2023
- LHTF award amount: \$3,000,000
- Located in Northeast Fresno- Northwest corner of E. Alluvial Avenue and
 N. Chestnut Avenue
- 44 Multifamily Affordable Rental Units (30% 60% AMI)
 - 11 units are LHTF-assisted
