

IT APPEARS YOU HAVE MISTAKENLY VIOLATED A CITY OF FRESNO PARKING REGULATION

In accordance with Assembly Bill 413, also known as the "Daylighting" law (in effect January 2025), it is illegal to park, stop, or stand a vehicle *within 20 feet of the approach side of any crosswalk* – marked or unmarked. It is also illegal to park *within 15 feet of any crosswalk with a curb extension* or bulb-out.





This law applies to both <u>marked and unmarked crosswalks on all streets</u>, including on one-way streets. Red curbs may or may not be painted in certain locations, but the absence of markings does not exempt compliance.

As a recommendation, drivers can use the length of a standard parking space (approximately 20 feet) as a guide to ensure compliance when parking near crosswalks.

Keeping areas clear of parked vehicles will help drivers see pedestrians more easily, reducing blind spots and the likelihood of accidents.

FULL ENFORCEMENT WILL INCLUDE FINES OF \$58 PER VIOLATION
